Infobox for the exhibition MUSTERUNG. POP UND POLITIK IN DER ZEITGENÖSSISCHEN TEXTIL-KUNST:

The examination of the material, new textiles and carrier materials currently inspires artists of different generations and origins from all continents. Curtains, wallpapers and carpets are rediscovered as image carriers of contemporary representations. With fabrics, textile décor and clothing, stories, backgrounds of historical, pictorial and global contexts can be retold. The rediscovery of traditional technologies is contrasted with enthusiasm for new digital technologies: digital technology controls looms in today's world or spins the threads into an augmented reality. Fabrics and their patterns are often also cultural symbols of identity. In the context of mass production of textiles and ecological sustainability, artistic materials research opens up new perspectives and possibilities.

The exhibition places different positions of internationally renowned artists in a dialogue, who explicitly deal with textile materials and at the same time explore their socio-political significance. It was conceived and realized for the Kunstsammlungen Chemnitz in 2020/2021, but did not open due to the lockdown (Source: Kunstmuseum Ravensburg)

Infobox for the exhibition SAMMLUNG SELINKA. GRUPPE SPUR:

Selected works by the artist group SPUR (1957-1965) await you in the salon. SPUR is one of the most important German artists' communities after the Second World War and revolted with art-politically provocative activities against the experienced contradictions of reality and social appearance. Founded by the painters Helmut Sturm (1932-2008), Heimrad Prem (1934-'1978), HP Zimmer ("1936-1992") and the sculptor Lothar Fischer (1933-2004), SPUR finds a highly independent painting that combines figurative and abstract.
